The SSPX now has 707 priests! After this summer's ordination the SSPX has grown a lot. During the past 30 days, 6 were ordained in the United States, 8 were ordained in Switzerland, and 3 in Germany. The SSPX is currently the 5th largest Catholic Congregation of priests in the world. Only the Jesuit, Franciscan, Benedictine, and Augustinian orders currently have more members.
