CHRISTMAS RAFFLE

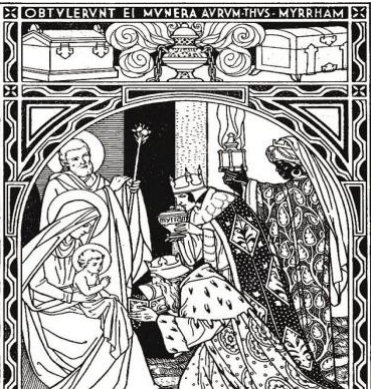
