ATTENDANCE AT MASS

The Mass and the liturgy follow a rite which has been set by the Church and by Tradition, according to rules which are not arbitrary. The least movement in liturgy is charged with a meaning and sense. We will endeavor here to show how much more one may profit from the liturgy by a closer participation of all the movements, postures, prayers or chant of our ceremonies.

Dom Gueranger says: *“Liturgy is tradition at its highest degree of power and solemnity...the essence of Catholic liturgy is found in an alliance of poetry with the Faith.”*

If we would like to drink from the pure source of Tradition, if we would like to pray and believe as the Church does, then how agreeable it should be to us to adapt ourselves to all her gestures and rubrics, so that her faith and her all-powerful prayer can penetrate our souls.

Listen to what Dom Gueranger had to say a little over a century ago. He was neither a modernist nor a progressive!:

*‘The prayer of the Church is the most pleasing to the ears and heart of God, and, besides, the most powerful. Blessed are those who pray with the Church...Thus for more than a thousand years, we have seen that the Church, who would pray seven times a day in her temples and in the middle of the night, never prayed alone? The faithful kept Her company and took delight in the manna which was hidden under the words and the mysteries of the divine liturgy....’*

Just how weak the faith has become may be seen from the fact that the faithful don’t seem to have the need anymore to use chant as the most lofty form and expression of their prayer.

(Dom Gueranger - 1870).

In the absence of a formal obligation, it is clearly fitting that, throughout the Mass, the faithful conform their posture to that of those in the sanctuary  
Pope Pius XI (*L’Ami du clerge*, 1925).

Here are a few new rules for St. Thomas Becket taken from the rubrics of the clerical choir and applied to the laity in order to clarify a few confusing parts at High Mass.

- From the prayers at the foot of the altar until the end of the *Kyrie* - KNEEL.
- STAND when the priest intones the *Gloria in excelsis Deo*.
- STAND when the server comes to incense the congregation, not when the priest is incensed.
- Sanctus – STAND until finished singing
- Agnus Dei -STAND until finished singing
