**CONSECRATION TO OUR LADY – MARCH 25**

For those interested in consecrating themselves to Our Lady according to St. Louis de Montfort (or renewing), a consecration is being planned for parishioners on **March 25** after the High Mass. We will start the preparatory prayers and readings (privately) on **Feb 20** (and for the following 4 weeks) and use the book **Total Consecration to Mary** by St. Louis de Montfort. There are two versions of the book available: a longer edition and a shorter edition. The short version is approximately 85 pages. The short version is easy to do, just follow the daily prayers and meditations. Takes about 15 min a day. Can be done as a family. *Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us!*

**ASH WEDNESDAY**  
This Wednesday February 18<sup>th</sup> will be Ash Wednesday. It is a day of obligatory **fasting** for those aged 18 – 59, and **abstinence** for those aged 14 and above. The law of fasting allows us to eat only 1 full meal on that day and 2 smaller meals that do not equal the main meal. The law of abstinence forbids us to eat meat, meat products or even broth made from meat. Please be generous in doing penance for sin! Have a good lent!
