Portugal will still be serving the missions in Hawaii from El Paso, and so the chapels in Hawaii will not be serviced from Veneta this year. This will enable Fr. McManus to help with confessions in Veneta on Sundays. We are also supposed to receive a 4th priest, Fr. Greig Gonzalez. However, Father is currently not in good health and so we are waiting for a final confirmation on when he will be coming. Also, Sister Mary Peter will be transferred to Browerville for the next year to prepare for her perpetual vows. It will be a very important year of silence, reflection, and prayer for her. Another teaching sister will be coming to replace here at the Convent & school. St. Thomas Becket Academy and Church are deeply indebted to her for her extraordinary charity, generosity, and sacrifice. Please pray for her.




