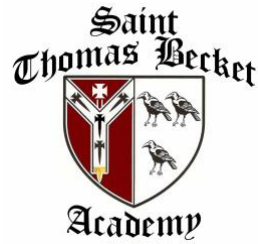

Spaghetti Dinner Rome Trip Fundraiser Sunday, February, 11th

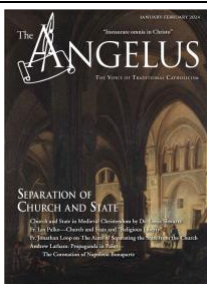
