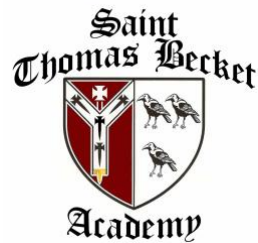

ASH WEDNESDAY

This Wednesday, February 22nd, will be Ash
Wednesday. It is a day of obligatory **fasting** for those
aged 18 – 59, and **abstinence** for those aged 14 and
above. The law of fasting allows us to eat only 1 full
meal on that day and 2 smaller meals that do not equal
the main meal. The law of abstinence forbids us to eat
meat, meat products or even broth made from meat.
Ashes will also be imposed on Sunday February 26th.
