ST. THOMAS BECKET STATUE UPDATE

Pope Pius XII wrote: “*We desire to commend and urge the adornment of churches and altars.*” As Catholics we must always try to make our Churches more and more beautiful for the glory and honor of God. This is our goal with the new St. Thomas Becket statue. This statue will firstly be a beautiful adornment of our altar for the glory of the Divine Majesty and secondly, it will honor our great martyr patron. The German artists working on our statue have now begun the “gold leafing” process. This technique adds great beauty and solemnity to the statue but also makes it very precious, a sign of our honor and love for our patron. Below is a photo of the artist and statue in progress. 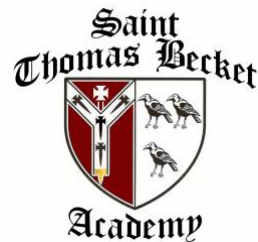
