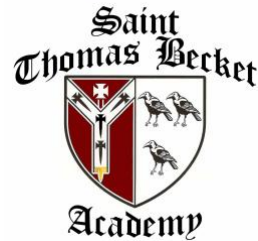

This is a powerful blessing! We will now have Benediction each 4th Sunday after Mass, unless it is impeded by another ceremony.

There will be Catechism today for Confirmation after Holy Mass. Please meet over at the auditorium.

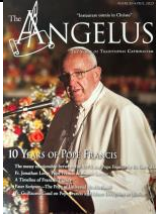
CONFIRMATION REMINDER
