SLIDESHOW PRESENTATION: QUITO ECUADOR



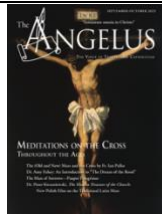
