GUIDELINES FOR HIGH MASS

Many of the faithful here at St. Thomas Becket have been asking me to clarify when exactly they should **stand** and **kneel** at High Mass. It seems that there are various opinions regarding these things here at St. Thomas Becket and also some confusion at Mass regarding what the faithful *should* do. I will make some rules about this, but I also want you to understand the reasons for these rules.

The first thing to understand here is that:

 There are no <u>rubrics or laws</u> for the laity as to when to stand, sit, or kneel. In the official liturgical books, there are only rubrics and laws for the priest, Deacon, Sub-deacon, servers, and clerical choir.

The "rules" for the faithful regarding standing, sitting, and kneeling at Low Mass or High Mass that you find in your personal missals that you use at mass, or in other books, are really only kind of "customs". If you check various missals from different time periods you will see different rules for standing, sitting, and kneeling. There are a lot of discrepancies. That is because these personal missals are put together by different lay people who have no official authority to legislate church law.

Also, customs about standing and kneeling are very different in different chapels and places. This means that differences of opinion exist in different chapels, and in different countries, as to when exactly to stand, sit, or kneel. If you visit the various chapels in the USA, or the different countries in Europe, or around the world you will see many, many differences in traditional Latin Mass chapels as to when the people stand, sit, or kneel. There is no "right way" or "dogma" or "rubric" about when to stand, sit, or kneel for the faithful. Standing, sitting, or kneeling for the laity has always been by custom, not by rubric.

On the other hand, if everyone does whatever he wants then there would be chaos at Mass. We need some kind of unity, order, and rules for everyone. Each individual should not decide for himself. Holy Mass is the Sacrifice of the Cross and the <u>public worship</u> of God together with Jesus Christ. This means we should be UNITED in our prayers and gestures. *Continued on next page...*

 So, if there are no rubrics for the faithful about standing, sitting, and kneeling, what rules or customs should they follow at High Mass?

To answer this question, most theologians and rubricians recommend that the faithful follow the rubrics of the clerical choir since there are rubrics for them. However, strictly speaking, they are not rubrics for the faithful, but only applied to the faithful as guidelines. In the end, the priest and especially the prior makes the final rules for the chapel regarding these things in order to bring unity.

Therefore, here are a few rules for St. Thomas Becket taken from the rubrics of the clerical choir and applied to the laity in order to clarify a few confusing parts at High Mass.

- From the prayers at the foot of the altar until the end of the Kyrie - KNEEL.
- STAND when the priest intones the Gloria in excelsis Deo.
- STAND when the server comes to incense the congregation, not when the priest is incensed.
- Sanctus STAND until finished singing
- Agnus Dei -STAND until finished singing

These questions and others related to the Holy Mass will be addressed in Adult Catechism for the next couple of weeks. Please try to come if you would like more information. Please do not hesitate to talk to us priests about these things if you have questions.

I please ask that you obey these rules during High Mass. Thank you.


