

TODAY'S MASS: QUINQUAGESIMA SUNDAY

The Collect of the Mass today: "O Lord, we beseech You, mercifully hear our prayers; loose us from the chains of our sins and keep us from all adversity."

31 DAY NOVENA TO ST. JOSEPH

The SSPX District Superior Fr. John Fullerton has asked all the priests, sisters, brothers and faithful to pray a 31-day Novena to St. Joseph from **March 1 – March 31.** We will ask for St. Joseph's intercession for the following intentions:

- That the work of Fatherhood be recognized and accomplished within the Church and Family
- For correspondence to the manifold gifts of God in our lives.

This Novena will consist in praying the Rosary (5 decades) followed by the Prayer to St. Joseph (the one normally prayed in SSPX chapels after the Rosary) and thirdly, the Litany of St. Joseph. Then on **March 19**th, we will all make an act of Consecration to St. Joseph. Prayer cards for this Consecration will be distributed later. (There will also be an **optional** and supplementary 31-day Novena booklet made available of various prayers to St. Joseph written by St. Alphonsus Liguori which we invite all who are able to also pray.)

SUNDAY MASS SCHEDULE CHANGE

We will have a Sunday Mass Schedule change starting on the 1st Sunday of Lent, **March 6, 2022.**

- Beginning on March 6, there will only be 1 Sunday Mass. It will be a High Mass at 9:30am.
- Confessions will be held before that Mass from 7:30am to 9:15am.
- Adult and Children's Catechism will be after High Mass each Sunday.
- There will be donuts and coffee also available after High Mass.

ASH WEDNESDAY

This Wednesday March 2nd will be Ash Wednesday. It is a day of obligatory **fasting** for those aged 18 – 59, and **abstinence** for those aged 14 and above. The law of fasting allows us to eat only 1 full meal on that day and 2 smaller meals that do not equal the main meal. The law of abstinence forbids us to eat meat, meat products or even broth made from meat. Please be generous in doing penance for sin.
