31 DAY NOVENA TO ST. JOSEPH

The SSPX District Superior Fr. John Fullerton has asked all the priests, sisters, brothers and faithful to pray a 31-day Novena to St. Joseph from **March 1 – March 31**. We will ask for St. Joseph’s intercession for the following intentions:

- That the work of Fatherhood be recognized and accomplished within the Church and Family
- For correspondence to the manifold gifts of God in our lives.

This Novena will consist in praying the Rosary (5 decades) followed by the Prayer to St. Joseph (the one normally prayed in SSPX chapels after the Rosary) and thirdly, the Litany of St. Joseph. Then on **March 19<sup>th</sup>**, we will all make an act of Consecration to St. Joseph. Prayer cards for this Consecration will be distributed later. *(There will also be an optional and supplementary 31-day Novena booklet made available of various prayers to St. Joseph written by St. Alphonsus Liguori which we invite all who are able to also pray.)*
