NEW PRIORY ROOF PROJECT

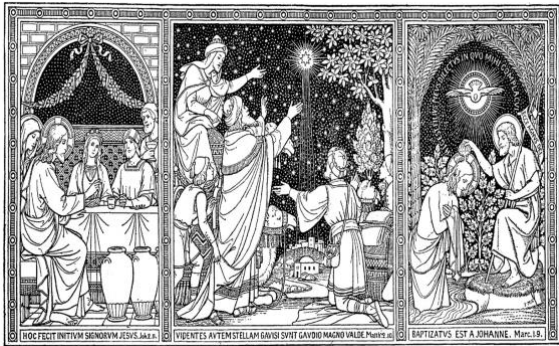
